Range Rules

We have several new ranges and have made many modifications to existing ranges and for this reason some of the rules have been updated to accommodate the new additions and improvements. As always, we want to remind everyone that while you are on the range at either of the facilities eye and ear protection is MANDATORY! Exploding targets are not allowed on the ranges. Steel penetrating rounds or armor piercing rounds (commonly known as “green tips”) are not allowed to be used on steel targets. Please be kind and courteous to other shooters, be your own range officer (no one else can keep you safe but you!), and pick up any trash before you leave (NO LIVE AMMO/DUDS IN THE TRASH CANS!!)
