Schedule:	The Regional Championship will be fired over one day.

Squadding:	The match will be not squadded. Each competitor will sign in at each event. When the competitors name is called, they will proceed to the staging area. If the competitor is not present when his or her name is called he or she will be removed and placed at the bottom of the list.
Entry Info:	Entry closes at 8:30 a.m. on <b>Saturday, June 16, 2018</b> . Entries received on or after June 1, 2018 will not receive a T-shirt as these must be ordered in time to ensure delivery.
Eligibility:	Open to the public. Competitors under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
Rules:	Current NRA Action Pistol Shooting Rules for will govern.
Entry Fees:	Regional Championship Early Bird Entry: (received <u>before</u> June 1, 2018) \$75 Regular Entry: (received on or after June 1, 2018) \$95 Junior Entry: \$65 Match Volunteer Entry: \$65 <b>No refunds after June 1, 2018. Lunch is provided with entry.</b>
Challenges & Protests:	The fee to challenge one's own target is \$10. The fee to file a protest is \$20
Classification:	<b>Rule 19.1 Classified Competitors</b> : NRA Action Pistol Classification will be used. <b>Rule 19.4 Temporary Classification</b> or <b>Rule 19.6- assigned Classification</b> may be used. <b>Rule 19.2 Unclassified Competitor</b> : Shooters that are unclassified in any discipline will compete in Master Class.
Equipment:	Revolvers and semi-automatic pistols compete together. <b>Eye and ear protection is</b> <b>mandatory for all shooters and spectators.</b> Minimum Caliber in Centerfire Gun Types is 9mm. Ammunition must meet a power factor of 120,000. Rule 3.12, holsters must be practical, safe, and serviceable and suited to the pistol used. Holsters must retain the pistol during any activity.
Targets:	Rule 4.2: NRA AP-1 cardboard targets will be used on the paper events. Rule 4.3: 8" diameter round steel plates, .375" thick will be used in the Falling Plate Event.

Range Equipment:	Turning target mechanisms are used on the Practical and Barricade Events. Falling Plates are equipped with mechanisms to lock the plates at the end of the time limit. In the event of a failure of range equipment, back-up timing will be accomplished using a timer. The range is equipped with rail-mounted moving target systems. Shooters may be assigned randomly to any mover.
Competitor's Duties:	Competitors may be required to act as range safety officers / observers for alternate relays.
Range Rules:	Pistols will be permitted on the range only when holstered or cased. Sight pictures will be permitted only at the firing line and at the direction of the Range Officer. The Rifle Range will be provided for practice draws, function firing, cleaning and repair. There shall be no handling of firearms except on the firing line or in the safe area.
Facilities:	The range is equipped with full restrooms. Drinking water, tea and lemonade will be furnished in the clubhouse. Bottled water will be available at each event in the staging area. Lunch will be provided to each competitor. <b>Additional lunches for guests will be \$5.00</b> . Please include the number of guests on the entry form and attach payment for guest meals with entry fee.
