RANGE ABUSE

Anyone shooting, or otherwise destroying range property including barrels, fixed and portable barricades, signs, structures, or wooden match props will have their membership subject to review in accordance with the disciplinary levels described in the Range Safety Rules dated September 8, 2026.

MEMBER SAFETY CULTURE

Safety is every member's responsibility. If you see something, say something. If you feel the need to say something to another member about a rule infraction, please do so politely. If another member feels the need to say something to you that is safety related, please respond politely. We all make mistakes now and then. Do not get your feelings hurt or let your ego get in the way. This is no place for an altercation. If anyone does not feel safe by the action of another member and can't come to a resolution politely, please notify a Green Valley employee, Discipline Head or Board member immediately.

PROHIBITED FIREARMS & AMMUNITION

50 Caliber BMG and any wildcat cartridge in the 50 BMG category is Prohibited on all ranges. Tracer, Incendiary, and explosive projectiles are prohibited. Armor piercing projectiles shall not be fired at any steel targets.

TARGETS

Used cardboard targets, sticks and clips are available in the Red Shed (next to range #1) for membership use.

STEEL TARGETS

Personal steel targets are prohibited from use on all ranges.

FAMILY MEMBERSHIPS

Life and Annual memberships are considered family memberships. Only one membership is required for any one family. A "family" shall mean the member, the member's spouse, and the member's children and stepchildren who are under 18 years of age. The Club member must be with the family members at all times.

CLUB MEMBER GUEST LIMITATIONS

Club members are allowed to bring a limited number of unrelated guest to the range. The member is totally responsible for their guest and should limit the number to 1 or 2. Guest Rule of Thumb: If you bring the same person to the range 3 times in a year, they should join the club. Membership does not permit a member to bring a large group of non-members to the club. Arrangements for work or church groups can be made if properly supervised for a fee. Contact the range scheduler for more information.

FRT & FULL AUTOMATIC FIRE

Forced Reset Triggers (FRT) and full automatic fire is PROHIBITED on Ranges #1, #2, #3, and #4 Action Pistol Ranges only.

Section 5: Definitions:

5.1 Small bore - .22 short, long, or long rifle rim fire cartridges. For the purposes of range specific cartridge limitations, all other rim fire cartridges are considered center fire. On a range allowing "small bore" cartridges only, .22 magnum, .17 HMR, .17 Mach 2, and similar cartridges shall not be used.

5.2 Magnum Loads – Given today's proliferations of cartridges, one must exercise good judgment as it is impossible to list all chambering's available. For example, lead bullets, loaded to traditional .44 Special velocities in a .44 Magnum case would be permissible in the indoor range. .45 Colt lead bullets, loaded to .44 magnum velocities in firearms that can handle it, are not permissible on the indoor range.

5.3 Center fire Rifle – While this seems self-explanatory, it should also include high velocity cartridges fired from handguns. For example, a handgun chambered in what is traditionally considered a rifle cartridge, will not be used where the rules prohibit center fire rifles (.223, .221 Fireball, .243, .308, etc)

5.4 Pistol Caliber Carbine (PCC) Rifle – A lightweight rifle with a short barrel. Many carbines are shortened versions of full-length rifles shooting 9mm, .357 Sig, .40 S&W, 10mm and .45 ACP caliber ammunition designed for pistols.

5.5 Shotgun Slugs – Shotgun ammunition firing a single projectile.

5.6 Buckshot – any shot shell loaded with pellets larger than #2's.

5.7 Muzzleloader Handgun (MLH), Rifle (MLR), & Shotgun (MLS) – A muzzleloader is any firearm into which the projectile and usually the propellant charge is loaded from the muzzle of the gun. This is distinct from the more popular modern designs of breech-loading firearms.

5.8 In summary, all persons using GV ranges are expected to conform to the intent of these rules, even if the letter of the rules does not specifically prohibit such activity. The intent of these rules is safety and the preservation of club property. When in doubt about a specific firearm or cartridge, do not use it until you have received clarification from a Board Member. The rules for each range will show firearms and/or cartridges that are allowed or prohibited, target type and location specifications, and what firing lines may be used. Certain ranges such as the Action Pistol ranges #1, 2, 3, and 4 have additional limitations that are intended to preserve the metal target frames and plates from damage.

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Armor piercing projectiles shall not be fired at any steel targets.**
